How to Write an Author's Craft Essay

- Collect entries on the author's craft.
 - Choose a spot in the text to study and name a few craft moves you see the author using.
 - Look for patterns of craft across the text in similar scenes.
 - Focus on powerful craft moves, like symbolism.
- Write a claim for author's craft, either focusing on one or many craft moves.
- Plan how your essay will go and begin drafting.
- Write introductions that summarize the story, explain the essay's relevance, state the claim, and write strong conclusions.
